*Theme:* Posters should focus on any lake or watershed issue, and may include topics such as lake ecology, aquatic life, aquatic plants, aquatic invasive species, lake health, and pollution.

*Format:* Posters should be no larger than 18 by 24 inches, in a style that is easily reproduced (i.e., crayon, watercolor, colored pencil, or marker).

*Required Info:* Include the student's name, school, grade, teacher's name, school address, and school phone number on the back of the poster.

**Posters must be received by the ILMS Outreach Committee no later than March 1, 2012.**

**Posters will be judged by participants in the 2012 ILMS Annual Conference, being held March 23-24, 2012 at Brown County State Park. The winning poster will be entered in the 2012 NALMS (National) poster contest. The winning poster of that contest will be displayed throughout the country on the 2013 NALMS Lakes Appreciation Month poster!**
